Las Lomas Elementary School \$70M Bond: Argument Against Measure R

Las Lomas Elementary School District claims they need \$70M (plus 32 years of 9 interest) to "repair/improve aging schools", virtually identical to the "repair and improve 13 aging schools" statement for the \$60M bond in 2013. 9

This begs the question, why are repairs not part of the normal yearly budget? 14

Just five years ago they wanted \$60M to "build classrooms for increased student 13 enrollment". But, student **enrollment has declined**, not increased. 8

Just five years ago they wanted \$60M to "to meet current health/safety codes" and now 16 5 years later they want \$70M to "meet health, safety/seismic codes". 12

Déjà vu all over again? 5

Just 5 years ago they wanted to "renovate heating/electrical systems" and now they 14 want another \$70M to "upgrade...electrical/heating...". It's amazing how fast electrical 12 and heating systems become obsolete. 5

If you thinks that's nuts, we encourage you to vote **NO on Measure R.** 13

Las Lomas Elementary School District is already spending \$432,377 per class per year 9 (23 students x \$18,799 per student. Source: California Educational Data Partnership 7

The average salary and benefits for teachers is \$109,585. 9

Subtract \$109,585 and that's still over \$320K per classroom per year. More than 13 enough to buy every student the best laptop on the market. 11

The administration just wants more of your hard earned money to pad their salaries and 15 fat pension plans. 3

By law bond fund cannot be used for administration. But, funds generated separately 13 from this bond tax can be used for administration expenses without limits. So, that is 15 really an empty promise. 4

Tell the Las Lomas Elementary School District Board to be fiscally responsible. 7

Vote NO on Measure R. 4
