ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF MEASURE [ ]

State laws are being changed to significantly reduce local authority over land use decisions and force cities to accept huge new housing developments. In addition, the owner of the Baylands has proposed a development that would nearly triple the size of the City. 15

The Council adopted this General Plan Amendment to respond to both threats. This Amendment would help ensure any development of the Baylands is on Brisbane's terms and not the state's. The Amendment also reduces the landowner's proposed development significantly. 14

The Amendment would allow up to 2200 residences and 7 million square feet of commercial space if the landowner meets the City's preconditions. Housing would only be allowed with full environmental cleanup, and only in the northern portion of the former railyard – from the San Francisco border down to Main Street, and west of the railroad tracks. 15

If the City approves a development plan this Amendment includes conditions to safeguard the City and future residents of the Baylands: 14

- Contaminated residential land must meet the state's highest residential cleanup standards. 11
- A reliable, new water supply must be found by the landowner and approved by the City. 16
- The landowner must ensure positive revenues to the City during development and after. 13
- Key habitat areas within the Baylands must be protected. 9
- The landowner must develop an environmental sustainability program under Brisbane's Sustainability Framework and it must be approved by the City. 10

The landowner also must submit a specific plan and negotiate a development agreement with the City, both of which must comply with the Amendment and be approved by the City Council. 15
