Ballots will be mailed to all of San Mateo County’s registered voters in areas holding elections between October 7 and October 29 for the **November 5, 2019 Consolidated Municipal, School and Special District Election**.

Return your voted ballot through the mail in the **postage-paid envelope**, using a **Ballot Drop Box location** or drop off at a **Vote Center**.

Any voter in San Mateo County can go to any Vote Center to:

-  Cast a ballot
-  Use an accessible voting tablet to mark a ballot
-  Register/Re-register to vote
-  Request a replacement ballot
-  Receive multilingual assistance
-  Register and vote on the same day
