More Days, More Ways to Vote!

Ballots will be mailed to all of San Mateo County's registered voters between February 3 and February 25 for the **March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election**.

Return your voted ballot through the mail in the **postage-paid envelope**, drop in an Official **Ballot Drop Box** or drop off at a **Vote Center**. Vote Centers will be open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on Election Day, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Any voter in San Mateo County can go to any Vote Center to:

-  Cast a ballot
-  Use an accessible voting machine to mark a ballot
-  Register/Re-register to vote
-  Request a replacement ballot
-  Receive multilingual assistance
-  Register and vote on the same day
