## **Request to Split Assessed Parcel for Condominiums**

This request to split assessed parcels for condominiums is for Assessor use for property assessment purposes only. It does not confer legal lot status, nor does it constitute legal lot approval by any Planning authority. If you have questions regarding legal lots, you should contact the appropriate Planning Department where the property is located.

To be eligible for splitting assessed parcels for condominiums before the first sale of a condo unit, the following criteria must be met:

- 1. A subdivision final map or parcel map must be recorded
- 2. A condominium plan must be recorded
- 3. It should be for four or less condominium units
