Fact: The California Department of Education dashboard (www.caschooldashboard.org) shows that our local schools continue to provide high-quality education and hold all students to high expectations. 22

Fact: Student performance rankings in most schools' Math and English Language Arts are even stronger. In the last year, most schools improved their performance by double digits per CORE data analytics. 31

Fact: Students in our schools continue to outpace State standards by a healthy margin. 14

Excellent schools are the bedrock of San Mateo and Foster City neighborhoods. Our schools provide a quality education, protect property values and maintain everyone's quality of life. 25

We're proud our community has supported local schools in the past. Independent citizens' oversight reports and public audits prove that past voter-approved funds have been spent as promised. 29

Unfortunately, we can't count on the State of California for adequate funding, and our aging schools need repairs and upgrades now. 19
