

Argument Against Measure 0

Shall the San Bruno Park School District be authorized to incur a new 40,000,000 Bond

Your costs of living are skyrocketing, the economy is dangerously uncertain.

You are currently paying **hundreds of millions of dollars** for bond debt and interest on the 1998 San Bruno Park School District Bond debt, San Mateo Union High School District bond debt and San Mateo County Community College District bond debt.

Now, the San Bruno Park School District (SBPSD) Board wants to add to your cost of living and the previously mentioned mountain of bond debt, by passing a new \$40,000,000 bond.

In 1998, San Bruno Park School District voters authorized the SBPSD to sell **\$30,000,000 of General Obligation Bonds that might end up costing taxpayers living in the SBPSD as much as \$60,000,000 to \$70,000,000 in principal-interest payments** by the time they are finally paid off between 2026 and 2030.

Now, the SBPSD wants you to pile on another **\$40,000,000 in debt that could cost taxpayers as much as \$80,000,000 to \$90,000,000 in principal-interest payments** by the time the debt is paid off.

To justify this \$40,000,000 bond, the San Bruno Park School District threw together a project laundry list similar to the 1998 SBPSD Bond project list. So what did the 1998 bond money really buy?

The San Bruno Park School District already has capital projects money set aside for many projects listed to justify this \$40,000,000 bond.

In 2010, the SBPSD Board and Superintendent diverted capital projects money into SBPSD employee retirement plans:

In 2005 the San Bruno Park School District sold the Carl Sandburg School for approximately \$30,000,000. California law required the Carl Sandburg School money to be used **only for capital projects**. In 2010, San Bruno Park School District Superintendent Hutt and Members of the SBPSD Board transferred **\$5,232,926** of this capital projects money into a retirement fund benefitting **SBPSD Superintendent Hutt and other San Bruno Park School District employees.**
