Voters have shown support for our schools by approving a parcel tax since 1999 to fund art, music, and reading programs. The tax must be renewed this year to maintain these programs in Brisbane, Panorama, and Lipman Schools.

The Brisbane School District has a vibrant art and music program that will be cut without the parcel tax funding. Our art teacher has created a comprehensive program of hands-on art and art studies. Students model clay, paint, learn about color theory, and develop an understanding of design. In music, students play instruments, build confidence in music productions, and find their creative and confident voices. These are necessary school programs that will disappear without the parcel tax.

The measure that has funded our art, music, and reading programs expires on June 30, 2022. Measure G would maintain these programs by renewing the parcel tax for another six years. **Without Measure G, the district will be forced to cut these programs.**

Measure G would cost property owners no more than \$131 per year per parcel, which is the current rate. No funds would be used for administration. **Seniors who occupy their own homes will be exempt from the tax upon request.** Seniors who have an existing exemption will be automatically exempt from the new tax.
