In accordance with Article XXI of the California Constitution and Proposition 11 (Voters FIRST Act), the State of California has redrawn the state legislative and congressional districts. The San Mateo County Board of Supervisors reviewed the new census data and officially adopted its new district boundaries and maps on December 14, 2021.

Dear Voter,



Every 10 years, following each U.S. Census, political districts are redrawn to reflect population and demographic shifts. The political districts that you vote in may have changed after the 2020 Census. Your districts, based on your residence address, are:

New district maps can be found on our website, www.smcvote.org, under Redistricting. These changes will be reflected on your ballot for the June 7, 2022 election, and candidates selected will assume office in late 2022 or early 2023. Until then, your current districts and representatives remain in place.

No action is required on your part. You do not need to re-register to vote.
