VOTE YES on Measure _ to support quality education for our local Woodside School serving elementary and middle school students. **As the top ranked school in the County**, with a high standard of fiscal accountability, we must ensure quality education for years to come.

Our school is aging, and while we have worked hard to maintain school facilities, there are significant repairs and replacements needed to support teaching and learning.

Measure _ is the result of two years of extensive work to develop a community-built Facilities Master Plan to address Woodside Schools' most critical facility needs. No other funding currently exists to appropriately repair our local school facilities.

Measure _ will: 3-7

- **Repair and replace** leaky roofs, and outdated heating and cooling systems 11
- **Stabilize and repair** significant creek erosion due to winter rains and flooding 12
- **Update** classrooms to meet current educational standards 7
- **Install** solar panels and batteries to power essential needs during power shutdowns 12
- **Improve** safety with security cameras and exterior lighting 8
- **Replace and update** kindergarten classrooms 5
- **Update** facilities for use as an emergency gathering shelter, center, or first responder operations 14

Fiscal Accountability and Taxpayer Protections Required:

- Measure _ makes us eligible for State matching funds. 9
- ALL funds are **LOCALLY** controlled for Woodside School. Nothing can be taken by the State. 14
- Woodside School District's high fiscal standard gives us a AAA credit score, the highest possible. 13
- Independent citizens' oversight and mandatory annual audits ensure proper spending. 10
- By law, **NO** funds go to administrators' salaries. 8
