**Pacifica School District \$70M Bond Tax: Measure G**  
**Rebuttal to Argument in Favor**

Measure G is a Prop. 39 bond measure: a mere 55% of voters can authorize its whopping \$144.9 million in total debt burdens. 6 15

California's constitution allows Prop. 39 bond measures to fund only SCHOOL FACILITIES, NOT WORKFORCE HOUSING. (Article XIII-A) 6 10

Pacifica School District's housing gambit may be unlawful. 6

Do teachers even WANT to live where they work? Apparently not. 11

San Mateo County Community College District and Jefferson Union High School District have drawn teachers into LESS THAN HALF of their housing units. (The former's units are over 18% vacant!) 7 4 15

Proponents assert no funds can go to administrators' salaries." A technicality. 11
