Over the past year, Belmont-Redwood Shores School District has completed a comprehensive Facilities Master Plan that identified several school safety and education upgrades to support strong core academic programs in science, technology, reading, writing, art, music, and math.

While some updates have been made in recent years, additional funding is needed to fix old leaking roofs, repair plumbing and sewage systems, update classroom technology and complete safety upgrades across all school sites.
