Our children's safety and education are top priorities. That's why Measure __ is crucial for our community and our schools.

The Menlo Park City School District, including Encinal, Laurel, Oak Knoll, and Hillview schools, has served us well with strong academics and dedicated teachers. However, the district needs to invest in our schools' facilities to meet critical safety, security, and environmental standards for our kids, teachers, and administrators.

- Replacing 65-year-old classroom buildings with structures that meet modern seismic standards

- Installing electric <u>air conditioning</u> in classrooms to address rising temperatures over 90% of our classrooms do not have A/C, which distracts from learning
- Improving classroom learning technology

This measure may qualify the District for over \$28 million in government funding and energy grants that wouldn't otherwise be available, helping us leverage local dollars for maximum benefit. The District has a proven track record of financial stewardship, evidenced by its AAA bond rating and millions saved through prudent financial management.

Furthermore, all Measure __funds will stay local and be overseen by an **independent citizens'** committee to ensure transparency and accountability.

This measure isn't just an investment in buildings; it's an investment in our community's future, supporting property values and fostering a stable environment where families thrive.
