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## **Rebuttal to Argument Against**

Our opponents' argument fails to recognize the facts – our public schools are some of the greatest assets in our communities. Over 300 students attend <u>Bayshore Elementary School</u>, and their quality of education is in danger due to a lack of state funding that does not address <u>21st century</u> educational needs. Do not punish our students whose only option for a quality education is through public schooling.

Funds from Measure HH will be used to construct future facilities and improve existing buildings. The District will be able to construct a new school to reduce student overcrowding, modernize outdated classrooms and other buildings, and make health and safety improvements. This allows State provided funds to go towards classroom instruction instead of being needed for critical safety repairs and improvement. Consequently, major repairs will not need to be postponed, and as a result, will likely be less expensive to make.

Measure HH is one of the most affordable ways for the District to make the needed changes to school facilities, and by law these funds cannot be used in any other ways than to improve our schools. Measure HH is a guaranteed, affordable solution to the District's repair needs.

To ensure a bright future for students in the Bayshore Elementary School District, we must vote YES on Measure HH.
