

IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF MEASURE O

This Measure, placed on the ballot by the Board of Trustees (Board) of the San Bruno Park School District (District), would, if approved by voters, impose term limits on members of the Board. [27]

California Education Code Section 35107(c) authorizes the District to propose a limitation on the number of terms a member of Board may serve; however, the term-limit proposal shall only apply prospectively and shall not become operative unless it is approved by voters. [41]

This Measure submits to voters a proposal to limit the terms of Board members such that no person may serve more than three (3) consecutive terms as a Board member. The limitation on terms applies regardless of whether the Board member was elected or appointed to their terms. [48]

A Board member who serves three (3) consecutive terms may serve again on the Board after at least four (4) years have passed since the last day of the end of their third consecutive term—in other words, a new three (3) consecutive term limit applies after a member’s four-year absence from the Board. [55]

For purposes of calculating the number of terms a Board member has served, a Board member who serves more than one-half of a full term is deemed to have served a full term and any Board member who resigns or is removed with less than one-half of a full term remaining is also deemed to have served a full term. [63]

The term limits proposed by this Measure, if approved by voters, shall only apply prospectively; that is, the limitation on the number of terms for Board members shall apply only to terms that begin on or after certification of the November 5, 2024 election. [41]

A “yes” vote on this Measure would impose a term limit of three (3) consecutive terms for members of the Board. [21]

A “no” vote on this Measure would mean members of the Board could continue to serve without term limits. [19]

This Measure passes if a majority of those voting on the Measure vote “yes.” [14]
