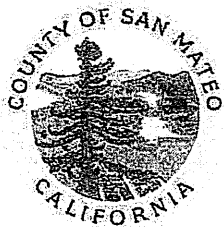

Rebuttal to Argument in Favor of Measure T

NO ON MEASURE T

The City spent hundreds of thousands of your taxes on this unnecessary measure. The state already officially certified our housing plan.

The City promises Measure T will provide more affordable housing and enable them to offset massive impacts with additional annual income, all without raising taxes. Ridiculous. In our "Argument Against" Measure T, we show their promises don't hold up.

Also misleading are the "projections" about what the City says could happen if residents **VOTE NO**. If they must identify additional housing units, know that identifying and actual building differ completely, considering state population projections are flat through 2060, with development projects paused for years. Analysis shows compliance can happen **without touching neighborhoods** – starting with approving fewer mixed-use projects.

The City threat to increase density in neighborhoods already happened two years ago. The state altered single-family neighborhoods via Senate Bill 9, allowing up to 8 housing units on a single-family lot.

Buried is the fact that **Measure T completely repeals voter-approved Measure Y**. Perhaps because Measure Y already puts more growth near transit/jobs/services and requires affordable housing, closing developer loopholes. The thriving city and vibrant downtown you love exist under Measure Y.

With unrelenting developer pressure and state overreach, it's the worst time to remove Measure Y. Its resident-created protections are time-tested, providing **power to the voters** to balance Big Money's influence.

Measure T is a bad solution to our housing and development future.

Vote based on facts, not fear.
