Commencing April 23, 2026, the **Sample Ballot and Official Voter Information Pamphlet** will be mailed to every registered voter in San Mateo County and available online at [smcvote.gov](https://smcvote.gov). The pamphlet provides important information on the **June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election** and the many voting options available to voters.

**Voting by Mail is Safe, Easy and Convenient.** All registered voters will be mailed an **Official Ballot** with a postage-paid return envelope, beginning May 4, 2026. Return your ballot in the mail, to a Ballot Drop Box or at any Vote Center.



**Ballot Drop Boxes.** There will be **56 Ballot Drop Boxes** throughout the County. View locations at [smcvote.gov](https://smcvote.gov).



**Vote Centers.** There will be **49 Vote Centers** throughout the County for in-person voting and voter services. For Vote Center locations and hours, visit [smcvote.gov](https://smcvote.gov).
